Thanks once again to **Charlie Piscopo** for the use of a crane, and qualified crew to put our docks back in the water. Great Job, once again!

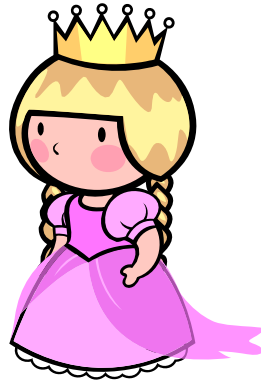
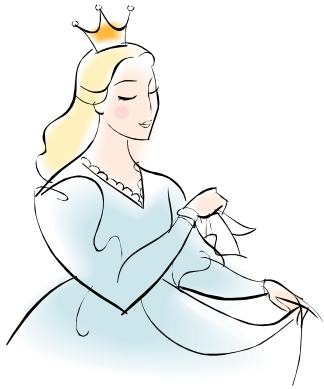
We will need a lot of help getting our grounds in order for opening day.

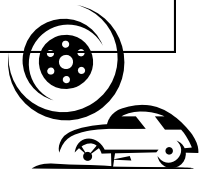
